

Part 3 – Authorization

- A. I authorize the Minister to disclose to the Family Practice,** and I authorize the Family Practice to collect from the Minister, the following information concerning any medical service I have received, whether or not the service was provided by a physician in this Family Practice:
- a) My name, personal health number, date of birth and gender;
 - b) A description of the insured medical services I have received, including:
 - (i) any health service codes reported to the Department of Health and Wellness (“AHW”);
 - (ii) the name of the physician providing the service;
 - (iii) the location at which and the date when these services were provided;
 - (iv) the amounts paid for the health services; and
 - (v) such other information about me as AHW or the Family Practice may need for ARP administration.
- B. I authorize the Family Practice and its physicians and staff working therein to disclose** to AHW; and **I authorize the Minister to collect and receive** from the Family Practice or physicians and staff working therein; such information about me as AHW may request for the following purposes:
- a) to confirm my eligibility under the Alberta Health Care Insurance Act (the “Act”); to be a patient of the Family Practice under the ARP; and for AHW administration and records purposes under the Act.

Part 4 – Additional Terms and Provisions

- A.** I, the applicant, agree that my enrolment as a patient of the Family Practice:
- a) is subject to the approval of the Minister or authorized AHW official;
 - b) is subject to any conditions or eligibility requirements that may be established or revised from time to time:
 - (i) by the Minister; or
 - (ii) by the Act, the regulations thereunder, or any other legislation or regulations; and
 - c) may be terminated by the Minister in accordance with policy formulated from time to time by the Minister, and I agree that:
 - (i) any such termination will be effective immediately upon the making of the policy decision to that effect;
 - (ii) it will not be necessary to provide me with advance or any notice of such termination of my enrolment; and
 - (iii) it will be fully sufficient for my purposes if the Family Practice or its staff informs me of the termination when and in such manner as they deem appropriate.

Part 5 – Terms, Conditions and Provisions Respecting De-Enrolment From Family Practice

- A.** The following terms, conditions and provisions are agreed to:
- a) The patient may seek medical services from any medical service provider other than the Family Practice or the physician who signs Part 2.
 - b) The patient may cancel enrolment at any time:
 - (i) by contacting the Family Practice during business hours and expressly requesting such cancellation; or
 - (ii) by contacting AHW in writing and expressly requesting such cancellation.
 - c) In addition, patient enrolment may be cancelled by a physician in the Family Practice if any of the following conditions applies:
 - (i) The patient chooses to de-enroll and communicates this choice to the physician;
 - (ii) The patient relocates to a location outside of the Family Practice drawing area;
 - (iii) The patient is admitted to a health care facility for long-term care;
 - (iv) The patient has a minimum of six visits, in aggregate total, with one or more physicians outside of the Family Practice to receive from such physician or physicians a service for which the Family Practice did, or would otherwise have been considered to, receive payment under the Alternate Payment Program; or
 - (v) If, in the opinion of the patient or a physician at the Family Practice, circumstances determine it is not possible to maintain an appropriate physician-patient relationship.
 - d) In addition, patient enrolment will automatically be cancelled without notice if the arrangement between the Minister and the Alberta Medical Association allowing or providing for the ARP expires or is cancelled or terminated.
 - e) The Minister may, including as provided in PART 4, without obligation to the patient, the physician or the Family Practice, terminate the enrolment of the patient of the Family Practice under the ARP.
